



Bartle Guitar Studio Health and Safety Practices (Updated on 3/28/2022)

Your health and safety is of utmost importance to us. Here are the Bartle Guitar Studio procedures that align with CDC recommended COVID-19 guidelines:

- The waiting room is currently open. Please let yourself in and come downstairs to the waiting room if you arrive early or wait until I come outside on the porch at your lesson time.
- Masks are required for all students and family members in the common family areas regardless of vaccination status. All adults in the Bartle household have been vaccinated. Masks are recommended, but optional in the studio lesson room, the studio restroom, and the studio waiting room. I will be wearing a mask during lesson times.
- It is requested that students and parents wash their hands right before the beginning of the lesson time. I will wash my hands between all lessons as well.
- During the warmer months, positive air flow from the evaporative cooler will keep fresh air moving through the studio and vented out the window. High-quality HEPA filters have been placed in the furnace to filter the air in the house during the colder months. In addition, two freestanding HEPA filters have been placed in waiting room and the studio lesson room.
- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath), please reschedule your lesson or take an online Zoom lesson.

Please don't hesitate to contact me with any questions or concerns. I will continue to monitor the CDC website to ensure that Bartle Guitar Studio adheres to up-to-date health guidelines for our community.
