



Bartle Guitar Studio Health and Safety Practices (Updated on 8/4/2022)

Your health and safety is of utmost importance to us. Here are the Bartle Guitar Studio procedures that align with CDC recommended COVID-19 guidelines:

- The waiting room is currently open. Please let yourself in and come downstairs to the waiting room if you arrive early or wait until I come outside on the porch at your lesson time.
- Masks are recommended, but optional in the interior rooms of Bartle Guitar Studio premises and recital venues for those experiencing no cold symptoms. Masks are required for those with cold symptoms (runny nose/sneezing/congestion). I will be wearing a mask during interior lesson times and at indoor performance venues. All members of the Bartle household are vaccinated.
- If you are experiencing COVID-19 symptoms (cough, fever, shortness of breath), please reschedule your lesson or take an online Zoom lesson.
- It is recommended that students and parents wash their hands right before the beginning of the lesson time. I will wash my hands between all lessons as well.
- During the warmer months, positive air flow from the evaporative cooler will keep fresh air moving through the studio and vented out the window. High-quality HEPA filters have been placed in the furnace to filter the air in the house during the colder months. In addition, two freestanding HEPA filters have been placed in waiting room and the studio lesson room.
