#### Simplified Tuition Schedule

- Several long-time students spoke to me at the end of the spring semester about their wish for a simplified, easier-to-understand tuition schedule. Thank you for your input!
   Effective the beginning of the fall semester, the tuition calendar was converted to a set number of lessons per calendar year divided into six equal payments with time off scheduled throughout the year (effective summer 2025 for new, incoming students). The studio calendar and tuition details can be found on the 2025-2026 Bartle Guitar Studio Policy document (see page 2).
- During the summer semester, online flex scheduling will be available to accommodate summer plans and help students maintain their music skills. Individual lessons may also be used to schedule recording sessions for scholarship video auditions or music theory tutorials.
